After 2½ years with B.P. Chemicals in London Mike came out to Godzone to join A.M.D. at D.S.I.R. as an O.R. Scientist,


After 14 months with the D.S.I.R. Mike decided to go back to B.P. this time as the O.R. Officer for B.P.N.Z.
